Saskatchewan offers all newcomers a high quality of life, a strong sense of community, and employment opportunities - making it a great place for families to call home.

#### **CANADIAN UNEMPLOYMENT RATES & INCOME**

Saskatchewan has maintained low unemployment rates and currently remains lower than 6 other provinces in Canada with the lowest commute time to work. (Statistics Canada, 2021e)

Saskatchewan has 296 Rural Municipalities and a long history of welcoming newcomers to friendly and affordable small towns. 35% of Saskatchewan's population lives in a rural area – one of the highest rates of rural living in Canada.

In August 2021, 10,100 people gained work, a 1.8% increase, which represented the largest percentage increase out of all the other provinces. (Government of Saskatchewan, 2021d)

Saskatchewan has one of Canada's youngest populations. The average age in Canada is 41.1 years, compared with 39 in Saskatchewan and 38 in Estevan, 35 in Prince Albert, and 34 in Lloydminster.



### **CANADIAN AVERAGE HOUSING**

Average home prices in rural Saskatchewan are much more affordable than those of Canada's major urban centres, enabling many families to own their first home earlier.

## **CANADIAN AVERAGE RENTAL RATES**

The average cost of renting a 2-bedroom unit is much lower in Saskatchewan's smaller cities and towns than in Canada's largest urban centres. Lower rental rates free up income to advance your family's
