The Canada Revenue Agency implemented an annual tax on the ownership of vacant or underused housing in Canada effective January 1, 2022. The tax usually applies to non-resident, non-Canadian owners however in some situations it also applies to Canadian owners and many situations have a requirement to file a return even if no tax is due.
